Molest suspect waives hearing

RED BLUFF — A 30-year-old Anderson man accused of kidnapping and child molestation has given up his right to a preliminary hearing, Assistant Tehama County District Attorney Jonathan Skillman said Tuesday.

Bret Moore is accused of kidnapping a 10-year-old girl from Bidwell Elementary School in Red Bluff on Oct. 29 and committing lewd acts. The date for his trial is to be set on Feb. 14.

Child molester gets 27 years

RED BLUFF — A 30-year-old Anderson man was sentenced Monday to 27 years in prison for the kidnaping and molestation of a Bidwell Elementary School fourth-grader last year.

Bret Moore, who was said to have thousands of images of bound and gagged women on his personal computer, also pleaded guilty to molesting two girls younger than 14 in Redding in 2002 and 2003, according to Tehama County Assistant District Attorney Jonathan Skillman.

Moore, who abducted the fourth-grader Oct. 29 while she was on the playground at the Red Bluff elementary school, bound her with duct tape, molested her and released her a few hours later in a church parking lot, Skillman said.
